## Wellington Boots



**All** children will require a pair of wellington boots for use at nursery so they are able to make full use of the garden and shoes for indoor play. (Boots can be left at nursery.) Also, the children will need a warm, waterproof coat for outside play and a change of clothes in case they get wet or dirty. Please ensure everything is clearly labelled.

## Sickness & Infection

Please do not send your child into nursery if they have a persistent cough, develop a new cough or have a temperature of 37.8 or above OR if anyone in your household or support bubble has these symptoms. They must remain at home for 14 days. In the event of sickness / diarrhoea, your child will need to be absent from nursery for at least 48 hours after the last bout of illness.

## Personal Details / Newsletters / Information

It is very important that our records are kept up to date, so please ensure we have your current contact details, especially address & telephone numbers and the names of those with consent to collect. Please also ensure we have the latest up to date information regarding any allergies, intolerances or health information regarding your child. We need to be fully aware of any medication that they may be taking, whether at nursery or at home. Please ensure we have an email address for you so we are able to send important announcements, newsletters and get you signed up to Tapestry.

## Clothing / Lunch Boxes

It is very important that the children and staff can find the correct lunch boxes at lunch / home time as there are so many that are the same or similar - please ensure they are clearly labelled on the outside so that the practitioners are able to assist them. It is also very important that ALL bags, shoes and other clothing is clearly named, especially jumpers, jackets, cardigans, hats and coats. Please bring (and leave at nursery if you wish) a spare clothes bag for your child when they are at nursery as they may participate in water play activities or get dirty and we are unable to provide spare clothes at this time.

## Tapestry Online Learning Journeys

We use the online system Tapestry, which allows us to put our observations and photos onto a secure online system, giving you as parents and carers access to them at any time and in any place. We will need an email address to get you up and running on tapestry (if you are not already on there) so please ensure we have your email address. Your child's key person can be contacted on Tapestry also.
